I compliment you for not only your immaculate handwriting but also the clarity of thought and logical reasoning you shared for reducing noise pollution.


I appreciate your clever solution too. I will share your idea with our Product team for sure.



Assets: "Investing in Our Future"


In 2023-2024, our total assets experienced an impressive 16% growth, fueled by the strategic acquisition of cutting-edge technology and infrastructure, reinforcing our commitment to innovation and progress.


Revenue from operations:

Donations skyrocketed from ₹41.12k in 2022-23 to an incredible ₹52.55k in 2023-24, reflecting a remarkable surge in support and trust from our community.

Other expenses:

Administrative expenses saw a 22.6% rise in 2023-24, primarily driven by increased internship-related costs, miscellaneous expenses, and our continued investment in operational excellence.





Revenue from operations:

This graph shows the donations received over the years 2019 to 2024.

Here's a breakdown of the data for each year:

2019-20: Revenue from operations was 5,000 because it was the starting year for LFC.


2020-21: Revenue significantly increased to 1,13,115, marking the highest point in this timeframe.

2021-22: Revenue decreased to 99,157.

2022-23: Revenue sharply dropped to 41,118.08, the lowest point in this period.

2023-24: Revenue recovered slightly, increasing to 52,550.

2019-20: Total expenses were 5,947.


2020-21: Expenses increased to 16,400.


2021-22: Expenses peaked at 115,103, the highest point in this period.

This data shows a notable peak in expenses during 2021, followed by a sharp decline in 2022, and a gradual recovery in the following years.








